Stockholm syndrome is a psychological behavior that appears in certain hostage situations. The condition appears when the hostage begins to show loyalty to or sympathy with the people who are 39 him or her. In the most classic cases, victims continue to defend and care about their captors even after they escape captivity.

The term 40 in 1973 after the robbery of a bank in Stockholm, Sweden. During the robbery, bank employees were held hostage for six days. During this time, some of the employees became emotionally 41 their captors. They defended the actions of the bank robbers after the ordeal was over.

Dr. Joseph Carver, a psychologist, describes this emotional bonding with an abuser as a survival 42 for victims of abuse and intimidation. It develops as an attempt to survive in a 43 environment. The behavior has been observed in battered spouses, abused children, prisoners of war, and concentration camp survivors.
