VTubers, or Virtual YouTubers, are online creators who utilize a digital avatar to create videos or live stream on the internet. The first VTuber is Kizuna AI, who 1 for the first time in 2016, was created by a Japanese firm and has been famous for her lively animation style design and outgoing personality. VTubers like Kizuna AI and others attract viewers with their animated characters and entertaining content. They frequently connect with their audience on social media platforms like Twitch, 2 allows unique emotional connections and interactions with viewers. This direct engagement increases a sense of community and belonging among fans. As a result, fans often show their 3 and love to their favorite VTubers through virtual gifts such as animated emojis or stickers. They do this to increase the live streaming experiences in chats and help viewers feel more involved. Some studies show that the impact of VTubers on emotional well-being may be 4, but too much screen time may negatively influence young people's mental health and social behaviors, leading to depression and social isolation. Therefore, to keep a healthy balance, viewers should set boundaries on their time spent online and 5 more real, face-to-face, and in-person interactions. By enjoying VTuber content without becoming too attached, viewers can appreciate the entertainment and maintain their real-life relationships.

Many people regard nursing as a “female profession,” which strengthens stereotypes that doubt the appropriateness of men in caregiving roles. A recent incident in Taiwan highlights this issue. A male nurse was verbally attacked by a patient's husband when the husband 6 to the nurse's care for his wife. Another challenge arises from workplace dynamics. One notable problem is the imbalance in task allocation within the nursing team. Male nurses are often assigned 7 demanding tasks, such as lifting patients or handling heavy equipment, simply because of societal stereotypes about their strength and gender roles. This unfair 8 of labor not only increases their workload but also heightens the risk of burnout and lowers job satisfaction. Isolation is another major problem, as they are often in the minority within their teams and may be excluded 9 informal social networks in workplaces primarily staffed by women. Additionally, career advancement opportunities may be limited 10 some underlying biases that question their suitability for leadership positions in nursing. Healthcare organizations should actively promote diversity and gender equality through recruitment, mentorship, and bias awareness training. These efforts will create a respectful environment where all nurses feel appreciated and respected.

This question has intrigued many people 11 the invention of baseball is credited to multiple influences and individuals throughout history. Therefore, this makes it difficult to pinpoint a single inventor. One of the most recognized figures is Abner Doubleday, who was often mistakenly thought to have invented the game in Cooperstown, New York in 1839. This 12 was popularized by the Mills Commission in 1907, an organization founded in 1905 and appointed to determine the origin of baseball. In fact, baseball is a product of evolution. It is derived from earlier bat-and-ball games played in the 18th and 19th centuries. These games laid the groundwork for 13 would become modern baseball. As for the formalization of today's rules, it began in the 1840s through the efforts of Alexander Cartwright, a key member of the Knickerbocker Base Ball Club of New York. Cartwright 14 standardized rules for playing the game, including critical aspects like the diamond-shaped field layout and the nine-player team structure. To conclude, while no single person can be 15 credited with inventing baseball, figures like Abner Doubleday and Alexander Cartwright played significant roles in its development and popularization. They shaped baseball into the beloved sport it is today. Their legacies certainly will continue to influence the game and inspire future generations of players.

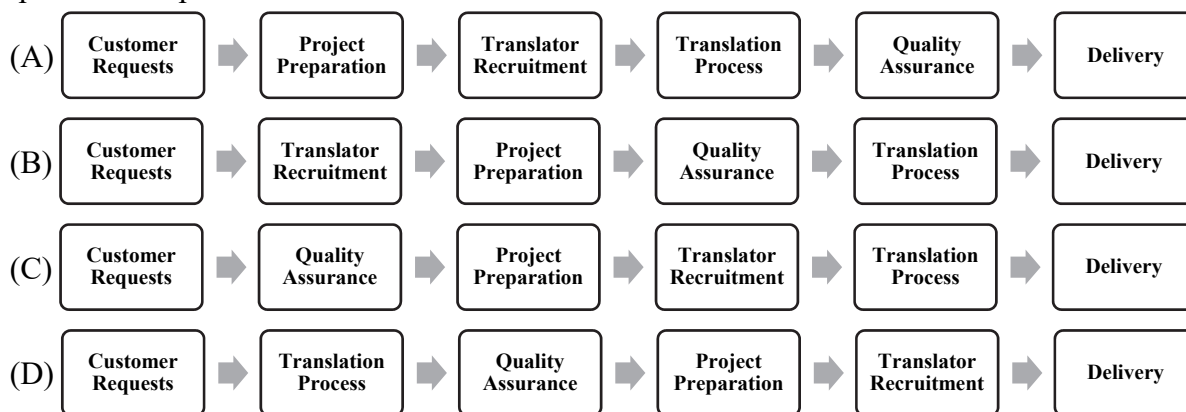
Requirements:

- ◆ Certification in project management (e.g., Project Management Professional, PMP) is a plus

Steps to Manage Translation Projects

- ① The customer communicates their translation needs to the account manager, who confirms all requirements are clearly understood.
- ② The account manager collaborates with the project manager to review and plan the project workflow.
- ③ The project manager creates customized quotes (price proposals) tailored to the specific needs of each translation project.
- ④ The project manager carefully reviews the source text for complexities to calculate an accurate word count, propose a realistic timeline, and offer the best possible deadline to the client.
- ⑤ The project manager oversees the analysis of the source files to make sure completeness and compatibility with translation tools.
- ⑥ The selected translation team (translator, editor, and proofreader) carries out the translation and performs a proofreading to verify quality.
- ⑦ The team formats the translated file to match the original file layout.
- ⑧ The project manager supervises a thorough quality check of the translated document to ensure it meets the required standards.
- ⑨ The project is finalized, and the project manager coordinates with the team to prepare the target file for delivery.
- ⑩ The finalized document is sent to the customer through the account manager to address any final inquiries.

Green Valley Cohousing is an eco-friendly intentional community by the Colorado River in Austin, Texas. Our mission is to enhance the health of people and the earth. Committed to fostering diversity, the community welcomes individuals and families of all backgrounds, ages, and experiences. With roughly 60 members, our group includes chefs, educators, naturalists, gardeners, photographers, athletes, writers, musicians, and counselors. Our shared values and collaboration are reflected in the democratic decisions at Green Valley. Our land features three wetlands and a year-round stream that once served as a habitat for rainbow trout. Located at the end of a quiet road, the property provides high privacy. About two-thirds of the homes utilize solar panels to reach nearly net-zero energy use. Unfortunately, Green Valley is not wheelchair accessible. We welcome members who understand and embrace cohousing principles and may be experiencing financial difficulties or economic instability. As a nonprofit community focusing on low-income housing, we maintain that all rent costs remain affordable. To achieve this, we share expenses for food and utilities, which helps to significantly drive overall costs down.

A stampede is an unexpected, panicked rush of people, often caused by fear or excitement. (①) It typically refers to a large, uncontrollable movement where people may push or knock others over in an attempt to escape or reach a destination. Large-scale events or global mass gatherings, such as the World Cup, can sometimes lead to stampedes and **turn** dangerous because of fan violence or poor crowd management.

Tragic stampedes have occurred in different contexts, including sports, religious, and entertainment events, as shown in the following table. (②) For instance, a deadly stampede occurred during a Halloween celebration in Seoul's Itaewon district on October 29, 2022, resulting in at least 150 deaths. Therefore, it is important to carefully consider different factors when organizing large events.

(③) To minimize the risk of stampedes, recent studies highlight the use of technology for early detection, predicting crowd behaviors, and improving crowd management. One approach is using Internet of Things (IoT) systems with vibration sensors to track the number of people. (④) If the sensors detect unusual vibrations, they can warn authorities, allowing them to take action before a stampede happens.

Another helpful tool is video monitoring with image analysis, which observes people in real time and detects dangers for quick responses. Wireless technologies like the Global Positioning System (GPS), and mobile applications help event organizers monitor population movements, transmit warnings, and deal with emergencies. Furthermore, ordinary people can wear sensors, like wristbands, to track crowd conditions and detect dangers, helping organizers react quickly. In addition to technology, preparation and practice are indispensable. Regular drills and training for emergency services help them respond quickly in case of an emergency. By combining technology with careful preparation and useful strategies, stampedes may be avoided, and people's safety at major events can be improved.

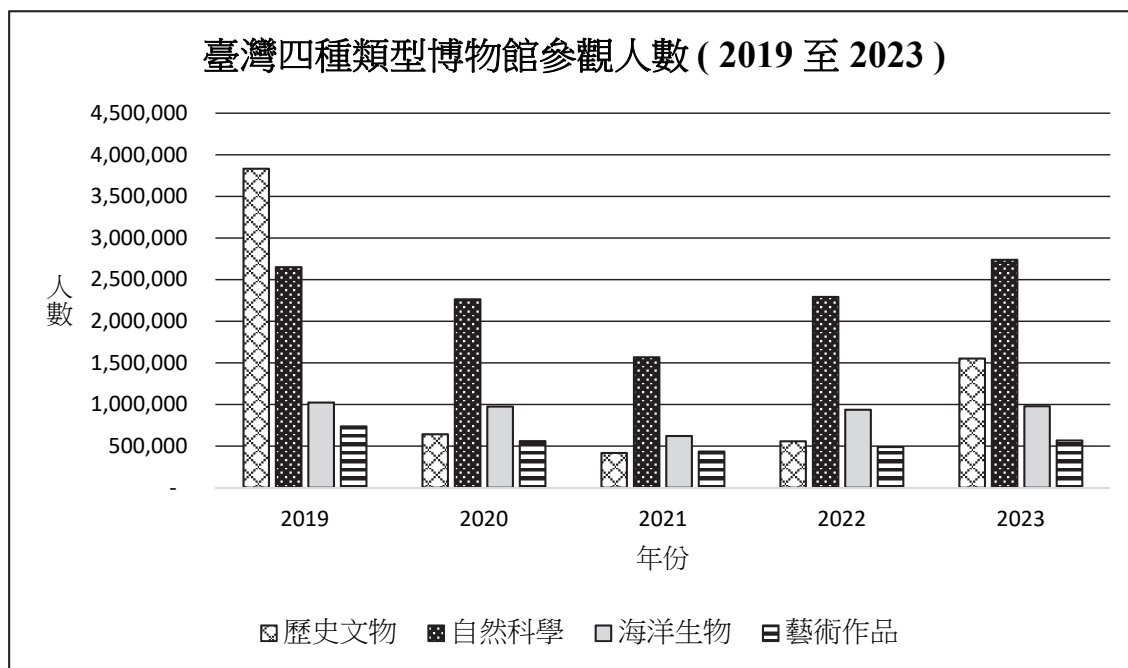
